This lovely walk stretches from the outskirts of a pretty village called Woodleigh following the old disused railway tracks through the sheltered trees, lined with Primroses and Bluebells in Spring. The mile long walk from Woodleigh to the railway bridge is perfect for a short walk or if you are feeling adventurous cross over the bridge, follow the river back downstream and head into the village of Loddiswell.
